

**Press Statement by Prime Minister for inclusion in papers  
in Hoveyng during week commencing 13th January, 1964.**

The Prime Minister, Sir Robert Munnice, said yesterday that he would be present at the declaration of the poll for the division of Hoveyng on Friday at the Divisional Returning Office.

The declaration, he said, would give him an opportunity to thank Hoveyng electors once again for the confidence they had reposed in him for thirty years.

"There are two things for which I am particularly thankful," Sir Robert said.

"The first is for the great and continuous help I have received from the best kind of party workers a Federal Member could wish for. When I toured the booths on polling day, it was so heartening to meet supporters who have helped me in a dozen Federal campaigns. It was equally stimulating to meet new helpers from the Young Liberals organisation and others who were having their first experience of booth work. The Liberal Party is in good health when it can hold its old supporters and win the help of our young people."

"The second thing I am grateful for," Sir Robert continued, "is that I seem to be blessed with the sort of constitution which will allow me to continue to represent the voters of Hoveyng in good health and with undiminished enthusiasm."

"The people have once again given me their faith. I shall do all I can to prove their confidence is not misplaced."
