ECONOMIC CONSULTATIONS STATEMENT BY THE PRIME MINISTER, MR. HAROLD HOLT

The Commonwealth Government will hold a further series of Economic Consultations with representatives of industry and commerce in Canberra next Tuesday (1st March).

The Government has been much assisted in the past by such discussion which afforded a valuable opportunity to Ministers to obtain at first-hand the views on current and prospective developments in the Australian economy of those directly engaged in business and industry.

On Tuesday morning Ministers will have discussions first with representatives of the Manufacturing Industries Advisory Council, and then with representatives of the ExportDevelopment Council. In the afternoon they will confer with representatives of the following national organisations:-
