Tribute from the British Prime Minister, Mr. Harold Wilson.

In a special message to Mr. Holt this week-end, the British Prime Minister, Mr. Harold Wilson, said:-

"MY COLLEAGUES AND I HAVE JUST HEARD WITH THE GREATEST REGRET OF THE DEATH OF LORD BRUCE OF MULBOURNE. HE WAS A STATESMAN WHOSE SERVICE TO AUSTRALIA AND TO THE COMMON/HEALTH WILL BE LONG REMEMBERED BY ALL HIS MANY FRIENDS IN BRITAIN. WE RECALL IN PARTICULAR ALL THAT HE DID HERE AS HIGH COMMISSIONER AND AS A COLLEAGUE DURING WORLD WAR TWO. I FERSONALLY WORKED CLOSELY WITH HIM FOR FOUR MONTHS AT THE FOOD AND AGRICULTURE ORGANISATION CONFERENCE IN WASHINGTON IN 1947 AND REMEMBER WELL HIS PRACTICAL AND IMAGINATIVE APPROACH TO THE PROBLEMS OF DEVELOPING COUNTRIES. HIS DEATH WILL BE DEEPLY FELT."
