VISIT BY THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH - OCTOBER 1973

On 2 March 1973 the Prime Minister's Press Statement No. 59 stated that after The Queen's departure for London following the opening of the Sydney Opera House, The Duke of Edinburgh will visit each of the Australian States to make contact with local organisers of The Duke of Edinburgh's Award in Australia, to present Gold Awards and to see Award work in action.

The itinerary which has received The Duke of Edinburgh's approval, has been worked out with His Honour Sir Adrian Curlewis, C.B.E., National Co-ordinator of The Duke of Edinburgh's Award in Australia, and the Chairman of each State Council of the Award Scheme in conjunction with the State Authorities.
