VISIT BY THE VICE-PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES

The Vice-President of the United States (Mr Nelson Rockefeller) and Mrs Nelson Rockefeller will visit Australia as part of the U.S. Bi-Centennial Celebrations next week.

After visiting Canberra on Tuesday 30 March the Vice-President will travel to Sydney on Wednesday 31 March and leave for overseas on Thursday morning 1 April.
