TRANSCRIPT OF DOORSTOP INTERVIEW TREASURY PLACE MELBOURNE

Question

Do you expect any decision to be made either today or this week?

Prime Minister

We will be reviewing the context in which both Andrew Peacock is going to Asia, India and Pakistan, and I am going to America and Britain, and we will make any decisions that are necessary for that. It may be that some decisions ought to wait until we both return. So, I am just giving you caution. We are both embarked on important consultations and some decisions would clearly be better made after we both return from this visit.
