MESSAGE TO PRIME MINISTER, MR. MENZIES FROM PRESIDENT-ELECT, SENATOR JOHN F. KENNEDY

John F. Kennedy, has sent the following message to the Prime

Minister, Mr. Menzies:

- "Our two nations share many common tasks, both in our domestic affairs, and in our world responsibilities. I know that the association among our peoples will become even firmer in the years ahead.
