LOAN COUNCIL

STATEMENT BY THE TREASURER, THE RT. HON. HAROLD HOLT, M.P.

The Commonwealth Treasurer (Mr. Holt) announced today that the Australian Loan Council has approved an increase of £7,500,000 in the borrowing programme for housing purposes in 1961-62 compared with the programme approved at the June, 1961 Meeting. This means that the total borrowing programme for States' works and housing for 1961-62 is now £247,500,000.

Mr. Holt said that the Loan Council also agreed to an increase of £7,500,000 in the programme of semi-government and local authorities with programmes of £100,000 or more.

The Loan Council decided that, subject to the approval of the State Government concerned, semi-government and local authorities with programmes less than £100,000 would each be permitted to borrow up to a further £100,000 during the remainder of the financial year if they were able to do so. Prior to this Loan Council decision,
