## ROYAL VISIT 1963

He is scheduled to arrive in Perth at 6.15 p.m on Monday, in Darwin at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, in Alice Springs at 5 p.m. on Friday and in Adelaide at 2 p.m. on Sunday (October 14).

The tour will complete the series of visits being made by Sir Roy Dowling to all State capitals.
