PARLIAMENTARY DELEGATION TO VISIT
SIX COUNTRIES IN SOUTH EAST ASIA

Statement by the Acting Prime Minister, The Hon. John
McEwen

The Acting Prime Minister and Minister for Trade, Mr. McEwen, this morning announced that the Postmaster-General, Mr. Davidson, will lead a joint Parliamentary delegation to Thailand, Burma, Singapore, Malaya, Indonesia and the Philippines.

The delegation will leave on Saturday, June 22, and will be absent for approximately three weeks.
