PRINCE LEAVES FOR HOME

The Prince of Wales will leave Australia next week at the completion of his two terms at the Geelong Grammar School.

Before returning home he will fly to Jamaica to join the Duke of Edinburgh, who is opening the Commonwealth Games.

Prince Charles will leave Sydney aboard a Qantas flight at 10 o'clock next Monday (1st August), accompanied by Squadron-Leader David Checketts. He will fly by way of New Zealand, Tahiti, Acapulco and Mexico City, and is due in Kingston, Jamaica, on Wednesday, 3rd August.

The Governor-General, Lord Casey, will farewell the Prince of Wales at Mascot.
