MR. HOLT'S FIRST YEAR AS PRIME MINISTER

From press enquiries received today, it seems that some of you are interested in facts and figures to background a story about Mr. Holt's first year as Prime Minister (based on the anniversary of the swearing-in of the First Holt Ministry on Australia Day last year).

For those preparing an item on this subject, the following might be of interest:-

- In his first year of office, Mr. Holt has flown some 125,000 miles in the course of his duties.
- . He has had personal discussions with the leaders of ten countries (not counting those represented at the Prime Ministers' Conference in London). The meetings were with the leaders of Thailand, Viet Nam, Malaysia, Singapore, Korea, the Philippines, New Zealand, Malta, Britain and the United States.
