## Statement by the Prime Minister, Mr. John Gorton

The Prime Minister announced today that the Governor-General had re-appointed the Chairman of the National Library Council and six other Council members for varying terms of office from 23rd March 1970. He explained that the Parliament, as provided by the National Library Act of 1960, had already elected two Parliamentary members to the Council in the persons of Sir Alister McMullin, President of the Senate, and Mr. G. M. Bryant from the House of Representatives.
