Statement by the Prime Minister, Mr. John Gorton

Invitations have been extended to representatives of national organisations to meet with Ministers in Canberra on Thursday and Friday (2 and 3 July).

Ministers will meet representative national organisations in three groups - primary industry, manufacturing industry and commerce.

In addition, representatives of the Manufacturing Industries Advisory Council, the Export Development Council and the Australian Council of Trade Unions will each have separate discussions with Ministers.

I am sure that these talks, to be held before our Budget discussions, will be most useful in providing Ministers with the current views of those directly involved in commerce and industry.
