The Historic Memorials Committee, consisting of the Prime Minister, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Vice-President of the Executive Council, the Leader of the Opposition in the House of Representatives and the Leader of the Opposition in the Senate, is the body charged with acquiring official portraits of Governors-General, Prime Ministers, Presidents of the Senate and Speakers of the House of Representatives.
