ECONOMIC CONSULTATIONS

The Prime Minister announced today that the Australian Government has decided that the conomic consultations between Ministers and representatives of national organisations will be held this year from 6 to 8 August inclusive at Parliament House, Canberra.

The Prime Minister said that the consultations are held in the context of the Government's pre-Budget preparations and provide an opportunity for an exchange of views on the economy generally and on matters of importance to particular segments of the community.
