R.E.D. GRANTS - LIVERPOOL

The Prime Minister and Member for Warringah Mr Gough Whitlam today announced approval for two more R.E.D. Scheme projects submitted by the Liverpool City Council.

The first involves the erection of a fence around Amalfi Park (established in 1935), at a total cost of \$7,616. Australian Government assistance of \$6,680 will employ 6 people for between two and four weeks.

The other project is the construction of a pathway in Wilson Road at a total cost of \$6,028 of which the Australian Government will provide \$4,968. This will enable 4 people to have work for four weeks.

Mr Whitlam said that the proposals by the Council were in line with the R.E.D. Scheme's intention of providing employment on undertakings designed to improve local areas.
