## VISIT OF PRIME MINISTER OF TONGA

The Prime Minister of Tonga, H.R.H. Prince Fatafehi Tu ipelehake, K.B.E. will arrive in Sydney tomorrow (March 30) for a five-day visit to Australia.

He will have talks in Canberra on Thursday afternoon with myself and Government Ministers. Earlier in the day he will attend Question Time in the House of Representatives.

On Friday, Prince Tu'ipelehake will travel to Brisbane where he will meet Queensland State Government Ministers and call on the Administrator of Queensland, Sir Mostyn Hanger, K.3.E.

The following day, he will visit the Gatton Agricultural College, which he attended in the 1940's and where his younger son is now studying, before going on to Toowoomba.

Prince Tu'ipelehake will leave Sydney by air on Sunday for New Zealand.
