VISIT BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF FIJI AND ADI LADY CAKOBAU

The Governor-General of Fiji, His Excellency Ratu Sir George Cakobau and Adi Lady Cakobau at the invitation of the Governor-General are to make a State Visit to Australia from 28 April to 8 May, 1930.

The State Visit will be a significant occasion as it will be Their Excellencies' first official visit to Australia and will highlight the strong and historic ties of friendship existing between Australia and Fiji.

As well as visiting Canberra, Their Excellencies will visit South Australia, New South Wales and Queensland in that sequence.
