

PRIME WINISTER

ADDRESS BY THE PRIME MINISTER, MR. BOB HAWKE, AT THE OPENING OF THE LAKE MACQUARIE POLICE CITIZENS BOYS' CLUB 1 OCTOBER 1982

I AM DELIGHTED TO BE WITH YOU TODAY TO HELP YOU CELEBRATE THE OPENING OF YOUR NEW CLUB.

IT GIVES ME PARTICULAR PLEASURE TO BE THE FIRST PRIME MINISTER TO OPEN SUCH A CLUB IN THE 46 YEARS SINCE THE INCEPTION OF THE FEDERATION OF POLICE CITIZENS BOYS' CLUBS.

I have been impressed with the way the Lake Macquarie Police Citizens Boys' Club has tapped into the ... extensive resources that exist within this community.

- THE PROOF OF THE EFFORTS OF THE LAKE MACQUARIE COMMUNITY ARE BEFORE US TODAY IN THIS BUILDING WITH ITS MAGNIFICENT FACILITIES.
- These efforts provide a fine example of the constructive support and encouragement for the youth of Lake Macquarie that the rest of the Australian community should be encouraged to follow.

IN THE VERY DIFFICULT ECONOMIC CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE RECENT PAST YOUNG PEOPLE AS A GROUP WERE THE MOST SERIOUSLY HURT.

- They were among the first groups to be affected by the recession.
- THEY WERE AMONG THE HARDEST HIT BY THE SURGE OF UNEMPLOYMENT DURING RECENT YEARS.
 - AT MAY 1983 THERE WERE 176,800 UNEMPLOYED YOUTH IN THE 15-19 AGE GROUP AND 343,900 UNEMPLOYED IN THE 15-24 AGE GROUP.

THE REDUCTION OF UNEMPLOYMENT IN ALL CATEGORIES

AND MOST ESPECIALLY AMONG YOUTH IS THE SINGLE MOST

IMPORTANT GOAL OF THE GOVERNMENT'S ECONOMIC POLICIES.

- WE CAN ILL-AFFORD THE LOSS OF SUCH VAST PRODUCTIVE POTENTIAL.

HIGH RATES OF YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT OF THE KIND CAUSED BY THE PREVIOUS GOVERNMENT'S POLICIES ALSO CARRY SIGNIFICANT SOCIAL COSTS FOR OUR COMMUNITIES.

- A LARGE NUMBER OF ONE GENERATION HAVE

 BEEN DEPRIVED OF THE WORK EXPERIENCE NECESSARY

 TO EQUIP THEM TO PLAY A PRODUCTIVE PART IN OUR

 SOCIETY.
- THE FRUSTRATION AND DISAPPOINTMENT OF AFFECTED INDIVIDUALS HAVE ALIENATED SOME FROM THE SYSTEM AND PRODUCED INTOLERABLE TENSIONS BOTH WITHIN FAMILIES AND IN THE COMMUNITY AT LARGE.

WHILE WE CANNOT REASONABLY EXPECT IN THE FORSEEABLE FUTURE TO RETURN TO THE EXPERIENCE OF THE POSTWAR GENERATION WHERE THE CONVENTIONAL ECONOMY PROVIDED FULL EMPLOYMENT FOR EVERYBODY WHO SOUGHT WORK, WE CAN AND WILL CREATE MORE JOBS.

- THE BEST STIMULUS TO A STRONG AND SUSTAINED GROWTH
 IN EMPLOYMENT IS THROUGH A GENERAL RECOVERY IN
 THE ECONOMY.
 - THE GOVERNMENT HAS SOUGHT TO PROVIDE THE FRAMEWORK FOR SUCH A RECOVERY THROUGH ITS ECONOMIC POLICIES, INCLUDING THE 1983/84 BUDGET.

- WE ARE ALSO TAKING INITIATIVES SPECIFICALLY
 INTENDED TO LEAD TO PERMANENT JOBS OR TO PROVIDE
 SERVICES OF PERMANENT COMMUNITY VALUE.
 - AN EXTRA \$300 MILLION IS BEING MADE

 AVAILABLE FOR DIRECT JOB CREATION

 IN CO-OPERATION WITH THE STATES UNDER THE

 COMMUNITY EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM. THIS IS

 EXPECTED TO CREATE UP TO 40,000 JOBS THIS

 FINANCIAL YEAR AND UP TO 70,000 NEW JOBS IN

 A YEAR WHEN IT IS FULLY OPERATIONAL.
- A PARTICULAR MATTER WE IN AUSTRALIA SHOULD BE
 ADDRESSING IS THE FACT THAT TOO FEW OF OUR YOUNG
 PEOPLE ARE STAYING ON IN EDUCATION. OUR RECORD
 BY COMPARISON WITH OTHER COUNTRIES IS POOR.
 - THE PARTICIPATION AND EQUITY PROGRAM WE ARE STARTING IN 1984 WILL HELP, AS ALSO WILL THE 3000 EXTRA PLACES THE GOVERNMENT IS FINANCING AT UNIVERSITIES AND CAE'S NEXT YEAR.

THESE STEPS ARE, HOWEVER, ONLY A BEGINNING. THE GOVERNMENT IS GIVING CLOSE CONSIDERATION TO HOW BEST IT MIGHT FURTHER ENCOURAGE YOUNG PEOPLE TO CONTINUE EDUCATION AND TRAINING.

- WE INTEND TO DEVELOP AN INTEGRATED APPROACH TO YOUTH POLICIES THROUGHOUT AUSTRALIA.
 - THE ISSUES THAT AFFECT OUR YOUTH ARE NEITHER ENTIRELY COMMONWEALTH NOR STATE RESPONSIBILITIES.
- They are complex and interrelated. This will require extensive consultation.
- As part of the consultative process, Senator Ryan has called a meeting of all State and Territorial youth affairs ministers for November this year.
 - THIS IS THE FIRST MEETING OF THOSE MINISTERS.
- THE YOUTH AFFAIRS COUNCIL OF AUSTRALIA, WHICH IS Λ REPRESENTATIVE GROUP OF YOUNG PEOPLE, HAS RECENTLY PUBLISHED Λ REPORT COMPILED ON BEHALF OF THE COMMONWEALTH.
- IT DEALS WITH EDUCATION, EMPLOYMENT AND UNEMPLOYMENT,
 ACCOMMODATION, HEALTH, LAW AND INCOME SECURITY. ITS
 PUBLICATION FOLLOWED EXTENSIVE CONSULTATION WITH YOUNG PEOPLE.
- THE REPORT MADE A VALUABLE CONTRIBUTION TO THE CONSULTATION PROCESS BY BRINGING THE VIEWS OF YOUTH DIRECTLY TO GOVERNMENT.

STAFF MEMBERS AND VOLUNTEERS, MANAGEMENT COMMITTEES
AND DIRECTORS OF POLICE CITIZENS CLUBS HAVE SHOWN
THEIR STRONG PERSONAL COMMITMENT TO THE INTERESTS
OF YOUNG PEOPLE FOR MANY YEARS.

- As you can see, we in the Commonwealth
 GOVERNMENT SHARE THAT COMMITMENT AND SUPPORT YOU
 IN THE EXCELLENT WORK YOU ARE DOING.
- THE NEED FOR CONTINUING EFFORTS AND GROWTH BY ORGANISATIONS SUCH AS YOURS IS OBVIOUS.
- YOU HAVE A PARTICULAR ROLE TO PLAY AS A MAJOR PROVIDER OF LEISURE ACTIVITIES AND TRAINING AND THAT ROLE IS LIKELY TO BECOME INCREASINGLY IMPORTANT AS SOCIETAL CHANGES INFLUENCE THE WAYS AUSTRALIANS WORK AND PLAY.
- IN RECOGNITION OF THAT ROLE THE COMMONWEALTH
 GOVERNMENT HAS GRANTED THE AUSTRALIAN ASSOCIATION
 OF POLICE CITIZENS YOUTH CLUBS \$27,000 FOR
 1983/84.
- LEISURE ACTIVITIES ARE IMPORTANT TO ALL OF US.
- THEY IMPROVE OUR ABILITY TO COPE WITH STRESS,

 IMPROVE FITNESS, REDUCE THE INCIDENCE OF CHRONIC

 DISEASES AND LOWER THE HEALTH COSTS OF INDIVIDUALS

 AND GOVERNMENTS. THEY CAN ALSO CONTRIBUTE TO

 FAMILY COHESIVENESS.

As the Police Citizens clubs have recognised for many years, the particular form of leisure activity which attracts a person is not important.

- WHAT IS IMPORTANT IS THAT THE INDIVIDUAL DOES HAVE

ONE OR MORE LEISURE ACTIVITIES AND THE CHANCE TO LEARN

AND DEVELOP THE SKILLS WHICH WILL MAKE THAT ACTIVITY

SATISFYING.

THE POLICE CITIZENS CLUBS IN VARIOUS PARTS OF AUSTRALIA WOULD NOT HAVE WON THE LONG-STANDING SUPPORT THEY HAVE IF THEY DID NOT RECOGNISE THAT THERE IS A NEED FOR A WIDE RANGE OF LEISURE TRAINING AND THE PROVISION OF GOOD FACILITIES.

- My Government will continue to consult State Governments on the provision of sport and recreation facilities at community level to ensure that what is done achieves mutual goals and satisfies local needs.
- THE CREATION BY THE LABOR GOVERNMENT OF A MINISTRY

 OF SPORT, RECREATION AND TOURISM IS UNPRECEDENTED.

 IT ALSO REFLECTS THE IMPORTANCE WE ATTACH TO THIS ASPECT

 OF COMMUNITY LIFE.
 - John Brown as Minister is, I believe, very effectively translating the Government's interest into concrete programs of action.

THE 41.3 PER CENT INCREASE IN FUNDS FOR YOUTH, SPORT AND RECREATION MADE AVAILABLE IN THE 1983-84 BUDGET IS A FURTHER DEMONSTRATION OF WHAT WE WANT TO ACHIEVE IN THIS IMPORTANT AREA.

- LIKE YOUR OWN ORGANISATION, THE GOVERNMENT WANTS TO GIVE PEOPLE THE OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN HEALTHY. RECREATION, TO PROMOTE THE PHYSICAL, MENTAL AND SOCIAL WELFARE OF THE COMMUNITY WITH SPECIAL EMPHASIS ON MEETING GROUPS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS AND TO PROMOTE THE WELFARE OF THE COMMUNITY GENERALLY.
- THANK YOU FOR INVITING ME TODAY. I AM SURE YOUR NEW CLUB WILL MEET ALL YOUR HOPES AND SERVE THE LAKE MACQUARIE REGION WELL FOR MANY YEARS.
