## SPEECH NOTES FOR PRIME MINISTER LAUNCHING OF THE "GREAT AUSTRALIAN ANNUAL" SYDNEY, 3 OCIOBER, 1985

It is with particular pleasure that I accepted the invitation to Launch the "Great Australian Annual".

Too rarely we get opportunities to reflect on what it means to be living in Australia at this time in .our history. Each of us will have his own view moulded by the particular quality of his or her own experience. But we all share an interest in, are part of, and have contributed to what this book tries to capture - namely the spirit of contemporary australia.

THE WORD 'GREAT' IS QUITE APTLY APPLIED TO THE ANNUAL, IT IS STRIKING IN ITS PRESENTATION. IT MIRRORS FAITHFULLY THE RICHNESS AND DIVERSITY OF AUSTRALIAN LIFE. IT ALSO CAPTURES THE EXHILARATION OF OUR SUCCESSES AND THE DEPTH OF OUR EMOTIONAL RESPONSE TO DISASTER.

THIS BOOK OFFERS FASCINATING COVERAGE OF THE RICH AND
THE POWERFUL, SIDE BY SIDE WITH A COMPASSIONATE SURVEY
OF THE UNDERPRIVILEGED - AUSTRALIA'S LOSERS.

THIS IS MORE THAN A BOOK - IT IS AN EXPERIENCE.

THE GREAT AUSTRALIAN ANNUAL IS A RECORD OF THE AUSTRALIAN EXPERIENCE - THE 1983 EXPERIENCE OF LIVING IN AUSTRALIA AT THIS TIME IN OUR HISTORY.

Here we do not merely have a conventional coffee-table book. Nor is it an assembly of events that occurred in a certain year. Nor is it an anthology of contemporary writing about Australia.

THE ANNUAL - I BELIEVE SUCCESSFULLY -/TO EXPLORE THE CONDITION OF THE NATION AND THE ATTITUDES OF ITS PEOPLE - FROM THE SUBURBANITES OF HIBISCUS AVENUE IN KARINGAL, VICTORIA, TO THE BOUNDARY RIDERS WHO PATROL THE DINGO FENCE.

Reading through the Annual I was struck by the clarity with which it reveals the continuing state of tension which exists between Australians and their environment.

WHATEVER ELSE 1983 REVEALED ABOUT US AS WE PLAYED OUT OUR PERSONAL AND COLLECTIVE DRAMAS, IT CERTAINLY DEMONSTRATED THE FRAGILITY OF ANY ASPIRATIONS WE HAVE TO MASTER NATURE. 1983 WAS A YEAR WHEN NATURE, IN FAIRLY BRUTAL TERMS, SHOWED US WHO IS BOSS.

THE ANNUAL UNFORGETTABLY RECORDS THIS IN WORDS AND PICTURES.

IT HAS BEEN SAID THAT A PICTURE IS WORTH A THOUSAND WORDS.

THIS IS CERTAINLY TRUE OF THE PICTURES GATHERED HERE.

YOU WILL ALSO FIND THAT IN THIS CASE EACH THOUSAND

WORDS IS WORTH - AND WORTHY OF - EACH PICTURE.

THE ANNUAL ACHIEVES A TRULY EXCITING UNITY BETWEEN THESE TWO DIVERSE FORMS OF COMMUNICATION - WORDS AND PICTURES.

THE PICTURES GRAB THE EYE, THE WORDS GRAB THE EMOTION AND TOGETHER THEY EXCITE BOTH MEMORY AND IMAGINATION.

WITH THE RESULT THAT THE ANNUAL FUNCTIONS AS A SORT OF DYNAMIC MIRROR WHICH PROVIDES NOT JUST A REFLECTION BUT A VISION OF OURSELVES IN OUR ENVIRONMENT AND IN OUR HISTORY AT THIS TIME.

IN A VERY REAL SENSE A CERTAIN UNITY IN DIVERSITY EMERGES FROM THIS ANNUAL.

In the sweep of its pages we can re-experience the diversity of this great land - its climate, its seasons, its towns and cities, its bushland, deserts, plains and mountains, its fauna and flora, its resources and, especially, the diversity of our people ... colour, race, creeds, and pursuits.

IN CAPTURING THE ESSENCE OF THIS AUSTRALIA OF UNIQUE
CONTRASTS, THE ANNUAL ALSO MANAGES TO SUGGEST THE UNDERLYING
SENSE OF UNITY WHICH EXISTS IN OUR COMMUNITY.

THIS UNITY WAS VIVIDLY REFLECTED IN THE SHARED EXCITEMENT WHICH SWEPT THROUGH THE WHOLE CONTINENT AS WE REJOICED WITH THE CREW OF AUSTRALIA II. THEIR VICTORY WAS A SUPERB EXAMPLE OF WHAT WE AUSTRALIA ARE CAPABLE OF. THE TECHNOLOGICAL SOPHISTICATION OF OUR PRODUCT BACKED BY SKILFULL, DEDICATED AND UNTIRING EFFORT, ELICITED NEW INTERNATIONAL RESPECT FOR AUSTRALIA'S CAPABILITIES.

BUT OUR UNDERLYING SENSE OF UNITY DOES NOT SURFACE ONLY FOR GREAT SPORTING EVENTS WHICH ARE PART OF OUR UNIQUELY AUSTRALIAN LIFE STYLE.

THE TERRIBLE DIVERSITY OF DISASTER - DROUGHT, FIRE AND FLOOD - WHICH TOO FREQUENTLY FEATURES IN AUSTRALIA'S HISTORY ALSO BRINGS FORTH OUR BASIC AUSTRALIAN UNITY. THIS IS VIVIDLY BROUGHT HOME IN THE ANNUAL'S RECORD OF THE DROUGHT - THE GREAT DRY - WHICH HAD HELD VAST STRETCHES OF EASTERN AUSTRALIA IN ITS TERRIBLE GRIP FOR SEVERAL YEARS, AND THEN THE INFERNO OF ASH WEDNESDAY ...

The NATION CAME TOGETHER " YET AGAIN - IN A SPIRIT OF COMPASSION AND MAGNANIMOUS SUPPORT. THE CONSISTENCY WITH "WHICH AUSTRALIANS HAVE ALWAYS RALLIED IN SUCH CIRCUMSTANCES REINFORCES MY BASIC BELIEF IN THE HUMANITY AND ULTIMATE GENEROSITY OF OUR PEOPLE.

Many of the Quirks of the Australian character also are revealed in these pages.

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EVEN IN THE MIDST OF CALAMITY WE CAN AT TIMES DISCOVER IN OURSELVES A WRY SORT OF 'GALLLOWS HUMOUR'; YOU ALL KNOW THE STORY ABOUT THE FARMER WHO AFTER MONTHS OF DROUGHT FAINTED FROM SHOCK WHEN A DROP OF RAIN FELL ON HIM - HIS MATE HAD TO THROW THREE BUCKETS OF DUST IN HIS FACE TO REVIVE HIM.

Humour has its unifying effect. so too does our spirit of adventure, our willingness to 'have a go', our sense of fair play and our optimism and faith in determining our future.

These are what the great australian annual is about.

These also happen to be what this government is about.

ENCOURAGING THESE UNIFYING ASPECTS OF OUR DIVERSE AUSTRALIAN COMMUNITY BY FIRST FACING REALITY, THEN

- UTILISING CONSENSUS RATHER THAN CONFLICT
- SEEKING CO-OPERATION RATHER THAN CONFRONTATION
- AND HARNESSING THE RICH RESOURCES OF OUR COUNTRY
  AND OUR CHARACTER

UNDERPINS EVERY EFFORT OF THE GOVERNMENT.

ALL THIS TO ACHIEVE A BETTER AUSTRALIA FOR ALL AUSTRALIANS - NOT JUST FOR A PRIVILEGED FEW.

But I am not Launching a campaign; I am Launching the great australian annual - so let me now pay tribute to all those who have contributed their talents and time to achieving what is one of the largest and most significant publishing events in the last decade.

THE EXCITING CONCEPT OF A ONCE-A-YEAR BOOK TO BE KNOWN AS THE GREAT AUSTRALIAN ANNUAL WAS THE IDEA OF BOTH KEVIN WELDON AND MAX SUICH.
