The Government proposes to recommend to the Governor-General in Council that Mr J.V. Monaghan succeed Mr K.F. Brigden as Auditor-General when Mr Brigden retires later this year.

Mr Monaghan is currently a Commissioner of the Public Service Board.

Before taking up that position three years ago, he held senior positions in the Departments of National Development and Energy, Treasury and Finance.
