SPEECH BY THE PRIME MINISTER ZHANGZHOU WOOL TEXTILE FACTORY 24 MAY 1986

YOUR EXCELLENCIES, SECRETARY HU OILI, GOVERNOR HU PING

MHEN GENERAL-SECRETARY HU YAOBANG VISITED AUSTRALIA, ACCOMPANIED BY SECRETARY, HU MILI, IN 1985, HE AND I DECIDED THAT AUSTRALIA AND CHINA SHOULD CONCENTRATE SOME OF OUR EFFORTS ON DEVELOPING CO-OPERATION IN THE FIELD OF WOOL, ITS PRODUCTION, PROCESSING AND MANUFACTURE. THE OPENING OF THIS JOINT-VENTURE WOOL TEXTILE MILL GIVES TANGIBLE EXPRESSION TO THOSE ASPIRATIONS. THIS ENTERPRISE HAPPILY COMBINES ELEMENTS OF RAW MATERIALS PROCESSING, MANUFACTURE AND EXPORT OF FINAL PRODUCT TO THE OBVIOUS MUTUAL BENEFIT OF SEVERAL RELATED INDUSTRIES IN BOTH COUNTRIES.

MACQUARIE MORSTEDS IS A WELL-KNOWN AUSTRALIAN PRODUCER OF WOOLLEN TEXTILES. MR ROB HODGE, THE CHAIRMAN OF ITS PARENT COMPANY, GENERAL INVESTMENTS, HAS MADE A MAJOR COMMITMENT TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF HIS COMPANY'S RELATIONS WITH CHINA IN RECENT YEARS - TO SUCH AN EXTENT THAT HE IS NOW PERSONALLY QUITE AN ACCOMPLISHED CHINESE LINGUIST. EARLIER THIS WEEK, I WAS PLEASED TO WITNESS THE SIGNING IN BEIJING OF A JOINT-VENTURE AGREEMENT BETWEEN HIS COMPANY AND THE REIJING MO. 1 TEXTILE MILL. SOME OTHER JOINT VENTURES ARE UNDER CONSIDERATION.

DISCUSSIONS BETWEEN MACQUARIE WORSTED AND THE ZHANGZHOU

JUTE MILL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THIS JOINT VENTURE

HAVE GONE PARTICULARLY SMOOTHLY. INDEED, WE MAY SAY THE

CO-OPERATION BETWEEN BOTH PARTIES IN THIS JOINT VENTURE

IS AN EXAMPLE TO OTHER AUSTRALIAN COMPANIES WHO ARE THINKING

OF INVESTING IN THE CHINESE MARKET. THE COMBINATION OF

MACQUARIE WORSTED'S MODERN WOOL TECHNOLOGY AND THE HIGHLY

SKILLED CHINESE LABOUR FORCE WITH CENTURIES OF TEXTILE

EXPERIENCE HAS CREATED A HIGH QUALITY WOOL FABRIC WHICH CAN

COMPETE SUCCESSFULLY ON THE INTERNATIONAL MARKET. INITIAL

SHIPMENTS OF FABRIC TO AUSTRALIA AND THE UNITED KINGDOM

HAVE BEEN FAVOURABLY RECEIVED BY LEADING MANUFACTURERS.

In accordance with the program of co-operation we have developed under the umbrella of the Australia/China Wool Working Group, we hope that in the future more such joint ventures will be established in China to use Australian raw materials and semi-processed materials for further processing and re-export to the world market. This type of commercial enterprise makes the best use of Australia's advantages in wool production and China's advantages in labour-intensive manufacturing industry to the benefit of both sides.

IN ADDITION, THIS VENTURE SERVES CHINA'S MOST URGENT NEED NOT ONLY TO DEVELOP NEW PRODUCTIVE CAPACITY THROUGH THE INTRODUCTION OF NEW TECHNOLOGIES, BUT ALSO TO CREATE NEW EXPORT MARKETS IN WHICH IT CAN EARN MUCH-NEEDED FOREIGN EXCHANGE.

IT IS THEREFORE A VERY HAPPY OCCASION THAT I AM ABLE TODAY, IN THE COMPANY OF MR HU QILI, TO OPEN THIS PRACTICAL EXAMPLE OF CO-OPERATION IN ADVANCING OUR MUTUAL TRADE AND COMMERCIAL INTERESTS.
