The Vice Premier of China, Mr Wan Li, will visit Australia as a guest of the Government from 5-13 September. Mr Wan Li, who has responsibility for economic matters and is a key figure in the process of modernising the Chinese economy, will have discussions on these and other subjects of mutual interest with the Prime Minister and senior Ministers. He will visit Melbourne and Sydney, as well as rural areas.

The visit follows the Prime Minister's visit to China in May. It will continue the now-established tradition of regular, high-level visits marking the warmth and maturity of the relationship between our two countries.
