JOURNALIST: Were you pleased to hear of the balance of payments figures today?

PM: Well, they were certainly at the lower end of expectations, so that was good. But you can't, you know, can't read a final story into one month's figures, but we'd rather have them there than at the higher end of the range. Yes, that's true.
