I deeply regret the execution in Iraq of the British-based journalist, Mr Farzad Bazoft.

Like other members of the world community, I sent a personal message to President Saddam Hussein, asking him to exercise clemency in this case. I am deeply disappointed that my appeal and those from so many other quarters were ignored by the Iraqi Government.
