The shocking bombing in Oklahoma City has horrified all Australians. This was an act of criminal cowardice against innocent people, and we join you in condemning those responsible and calling for swift justice.

My personal sympathies and those of the Australian people are with all the victims of this senseless act - and with their families at this time of immense suffering.

You can be assured that if your authorities require any help from Australia in their investigations it will be readily and quickly given.
